The future is bright for Yar-Craft. Thank you for brochure, as you narrow the selection of your next walleye boat.

Yar-Craft is an iconic brand dating back to Jack Dallman in 1969. It is older than its sister brand of Bass Cat. The history of the company is filled with loyalty and passion that keeps it alive to this day. While its ownership changed, the brand's legacy never failed. From Schutte, the Suthers Family, and beyond our Pierce family ownership, Yar-Craft is as strong as ever.

New options for 2016 include AquaTrex flooring. Snap in carpet was all that was previously available. The Radiance Package is offered for more color choices including seat accents. Other seat color additions include Coal and Pewter. Both are Cool Touch vinyl, which removes up to 20 degrees on hot summer days. Premium models now include courtesy lights and an LED interior light bar with a touch switch.

There have been significant changes made to the construction and fit of the boats. Those include Vinyl Ester resin and stainless latches on the Premium Series, a move towards a full fiberglass floor in all models, seat mounting, and floor assembly enhancements. These are huge contributions to the overall quality of our hulls. Other important changes have been made in the wiring to reduce corrosion. From here we step further towards a future, outside the shoe box designs of walleye boats. Things we do for bass we are excited to bring to walleye anglers.

In 2016 we put our stamp on the new 2095 BTX. Since the redesign, the acceptance of this model has been much better than we anticipated. The old 2095 was overdue for a facelift. This one runs drier, tracks better and handles tighter than the legendary hull did before.

There is so much good going for 2095 BTX that we can get carried away on it. The Net Scabbard is probably one of the coolest things. It holds an EGO S2 net off of the floor, when most others boats can't store any net. There is the recessed foot pedal, freshwater wash down, an 11' rod locker and 8' rod locker, integrated livewell and baitwell, a second isolated minnow cage and non-native area, Plano storage box in the rear and so much more. The panel is laid out for access and one graph fits well on the pedestal, while you have ability to mount three (3) graphs on RAM or BalZout mounts.

Full consideration was given to everything we compromised on. This boat is built and tracks like no other. Yes, boats are a compromise as you give something up in order to gain something.

This model has the hydraulic steering option, for those desiring a Yamaha, Evinrude, Suzuki or Honda engine. Something no other backtroller has ever addressed. Mertens tillers are soon gone and other systems leave us rather nervous. Yamaha dealers needed this to be engaged on the market. We wanted to leave our mark in the evolution of Yar-Craft. The future is bright and this model is just a starting point.

The Quest Incentive Program is a big part of our promotion for both bass and walleye. Quest is being reformatted as we accept more events in walleye. There are more events than ever that qualify for Incentive money. Receive up to \$2000 per event regardless of the age of your boat. Yes, all the way back to a 1969 model! Oh! And your Yar-Craft multi species qualifies for bass events also.

Yar-Craft is eligible to participate in any event sanctioned for Bass Cat and vice versa. This is important when you consider Mille Lacs and the smallmouth focus you're seeing up north. These two brands stand together in our eyes, with a laser focus on improving them.

We are confident that Yar-Craft is a major segment of our future. We feel it has more potential for growth than anything we have. So much so that we have committed the best young people in our group to building and improving it. Scooter, Tony, Hayden, Joe and more are all diving in to improve both quality and design.

We challenge you to find a company in fiberglass walleye more committed to owners, both old and new. Committed to building a better product and striving to improve on a daily basis. Our staff has been dedicated to the brand since we took over the reins in December, 2011.

A few years ago we made a promise to improve and nurture this brand. This promise will be upheld, and we look forward to the opportunity showing you how much we care!

A. UNITE Stringer Engineering

The longitudinal and cross stringer design seamlessly ties into the knee brace/transom assembly. This distributes impact energy and engine torque throughout the Yar-Craft backbone.

B. Premium Vinyl Ester Resin Barrier

Yar-Craft is incorporating a premium Vinyl Ester Resin in the barrier coat underneath our high quality gel coat. This will add rigidity to the hull and prevent hydrolysis which is the number one cause of premature blistering and cracking. Other companies are using blends that have more cost appeal, but the effects are seen later in the boat's life.

C. Solid Mass Transom Design

A thick composite core, encapsulated in fiberglass will ensure transom integrity throughout the life of the boat. This solid mass transom offers better bolt retention when mounting today's heavy, high horsepower outboards. Strong biaxial glass ties this system into our UNITE stringer assembly.

D. 6-Bolt Custom Jack Plates

The custom plates made for Yar-Craft are a big deal. Added rail length, more support, and an extra tie bar gives you the advantage on big water.

E. Premium Gel Coat with Wet Flake

The same strategic steps, high atomization, and wet flake application that we use with Bass Cat are used to give your Yar-Craft a showroom finish that will last through your years of ownership. Clean lines, and a vibrant finish top off a sound hull structure that is second to none.

F. UNIBODY Hull Construction

We don't just bolt a cap on and send it out the door. Our hulls are glassed to the cap creating one solid unit to maintain structural integrity throughout a lifetime of big water use.

Our famous construction methods that make our bass boats so desirable are now utilized on this hull. You can't see all of the steps that goes into this boat, but we guarantee you can feel it as you fly across the lake!

Our experienced lamination team applies layer upon layer of strong chop on top of the barrier coat that has our Premium VE resins incorporated into it. Sure, we could get away with using the less expensive resins of our competitors, but the added rigidity and protection is appreciated after many seasons of ownership.

A full width, vacuum molded transom is then set into wet fiberglass. This is what we know to be the strongest transom in the industry and now adds significant strength to the entire boat as it's tied into our one-piece stringer assembly. Once these components are set, we actually suck the

entire process together with huge vacuum pumps to achieve the strongest backbone of any tiller boat made today. After adding additional glass reinforcements and floor assembly, all cavities are foam filled, sealed, and reinforced once again.

The streamlined construction has allowed us to open up the interior to give anglers maximum fishing room and increase boxed storage. Cockpit room in a tiller boat is a major concern and the new 2095 BTX now has significantly more space for you and your guests to get around the boat with ease.

When the wind blows and you are connecting with the chop, you will appreciate all the steps that are taken to give you the best ride of any 20' tiller available. This boat has taken on signature construction methods that has carried us through our 45 year boat building heritage. A fter two years in the making, the iconic 2095 BTX has been brought back to life in a big way. The hull is built rock solid. We have integrated the fiberglass supports, and grillage for a construction like no other walleye rig. It tracks better than it did before through some subtle tweaks.

This hull is available in two versions depending on steering preference and engine manufacturer. Choose between a standard tiller arm, or full steering helm with stainless steering wheel and turning knob.

Two independent baitwells are within easy reach for anyone onboard. The large rear livewell/storage box doubles as a great rear casting platform.


Our integrated net, tool, and ruler storage keeps you organized at all times. The inset rails are offset for easy access to rod holders.

Yar-Craft Boats extends to the first, original purchaser of a Yar-Craft boat the following warranties provided the boat is a 2012 or newer model sold through an authorized Yar-Craft dealer and said boat has been properly registered with Yar-Craft Boat Company. Yar-Craft warrants that it will repair or replace defects in materials or workmanship that occur within the applicable warranty periods, subject to the "What this warranty does not cover" section. The applicable warranty period runs from the date of delivery to the first original purchaser provided that the boat is delivered within twenty four (24) months from the date of manufacture. All warranties run concurrently.

Defects in structural parts limited to the laminated hull, stringers and transom: Warranty period runs from the duration of the first original (1st) purchaser's period of ownership, or ten years. The transfered warranty period to a 2nd purchaser runs ten (10) years from the original delivery date, regardless of when the warranty is transfered.

Defects in the following factory installed parts, and components will have a warranty period of two (2) years from the first original purchase date, unless otherwise covered by their manufacturer. This warranty may be transfered.

- 1. Carpet fading (except from spills or leaks).
- 2. Steering helm, cylinder, hoses, and cables.
- 3. Boat electrical system, including switches.
- 4. Seats and pedestals.
- 5. Fuel tanks.
- 6. Deck hardware such as locks, cleats, and fasteners.
- 7. Aeration pumps, hoses, and valves.
- 8. Bilge pumps, hoses, and valves.
- 9. Yar-Craft Trailers from EZ Loader carry their own warranty (See EZ Loader Trailer Warranty)

Remaining factory installed parts and components: Warranty period runs one (1) year from the date of delivery to the original retail purchaser. Defects in the exterior cosmetic gelcoat finish (cracking, crazing or fading): Warranty period runs one (1) year from the date of delivery to the original retail purchaser.

Repairs will only be authorized after Yar-Craft Boats is satisfied that there is a defect in material or workmanship.

Coverage remaining under the Warranty period may be transferred by an authorized Yar-Craft dealer, or Yar-Craft, to a 2nd purchaser for a \$100 fee. The transfer must occur within five (5) years of the original retail sale. The transfer fee must be paid within 30 days of purchase of the used boat to transfer the warranty. Proof of purchase date required. The purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy is the repair or replacement at Yar-Craft Boats sole option of parts and components covered by this warranty. This Yar-Craft boat, including any alleged defective part, must be returned to an authorized Yar-Craft dealer within the applicable warranty period to obtain warranty service. The Yar-Craft dealer will carry out the warranty procedures on the owner's behalf. All warranty work will be performed at an authorized dealer, at the Yar-Craft factory, or at another repair facility that Yar-Craft Boats selects. The purchaser is responsible for expenses associated with transporting the boat to and from the repair facility.

An action for breach of warranty shall be barred unless it is commenced within two (2) years from the date the cause of action accrues. An action for breach of any duty or obligation to repair or replace shall be barred unless it is commenced within one (1) year from the date the cause of action accrues, regardless of any time remaining in the warranty period.

What This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- 1. Engines, out drive, controls, gauges, fuel senders, propellers, batteries, and/or other equipment or accessories that are not manufactured by Yar-Craft Boats, whether or not they are warranted by other manufacturers (except as noted).
- 2. External finishes gel coat, stress fractures, decals, rubber, or plastic composites.
- 3. Carpet and upholstery wear, fraying, or tearing.
- 4. A boat, or its components, that have been altered or modified, as to adversely affect its operation, performance, or durability.
- 5. Any damage resulting from an impact with another object.
- 6. Windshield breakage or leakage around windshield(s), hatches, or other designed openings.
- 7. Estimated characteristics such as weight, speed, or fuel consumption.
- 8. A boat, which has been overpowered according to the maximum recommended engine horsepower specified, on the capacity plate, which has been altered by the use of a transom bracket, or jack plate in excess of eight (8) inches, or six (6) bolts.
- 9. Any boat which has been misused, used in a negligent manner, used for racing, in rental or other commercial uses, used without normal maintenance, operated contrary to any normal intended use as recreations for Yar-Craft Boats, involved in an accident, operated in violation of any Federal, State, Coast Guard, or other governmental agency laws, rules, and regulations.
- 10. Loss of time, inconvenience, boat payments, retail charges, travel expense, loss of use, haul out, launch, towing, and storage charges, loss or damage to personal property, or other remedies not specifically allowed and are consumer bearance.
- 11. Dealer preparation, cleaning, final adjustments, and alignments done in preparing the boat for delivery.
- 12. Damage caused to transom because of loose or not tightened motor bolts.

Remedy under this warranty is expressly limited to repair or replacement or defects in materials or workmanship, and does not include incidental or consequential damages, which are specifically disclaimed. There are no warranties which extend beyond the description on the face hereof. This document contains the entire warranty given by Yar-Craft Boats, and does not authorize any person or persona, including Yar-Craft dealers, to change the terms of this expressed limited warranty. Yar-Craft reserves the right to change or improve the design or manufacture of Yar-Craft Boats without obligation to modify any boat previously manufactured, and at any time.

Dealers: Before a warranty repair is initiated, an authorization form needs to be completed by the dealer, and faxed or mailed to Yar-Craft for signature, authorization, and review. No warranties will be authorized or approved via e-mail or phone. Faxed or mailed claims and authorizations are the only acceptable procedures. Parts will be provided by Yar-Craft with return policies noted on the triplicate form. Warranty department at Yar-Craft Boats will authorize the repair and then fax or mail authorization back to the dealer. Photos and written explanations for warranty work may be required. These should be submitted along with the warranty claim form to Yar-Craft Boats for pre-approval.

When the warranty repair is completed, a copy of the authorization form and a copy of the parts invoice should be mailed or faxed to Yar-Craft for proper dealer credit. A credit for the total claim amount will be posted to dealer's account once the copy of the authorized claim form and parts invoice are returned and reviewed.

Yar-Craft Boats will strive to accommodate all dealers in their warranty endeavors; however, we reserve the right to adjust labor hours if in our opinion claimed labor appears excessive. The dealer will be advised of any adjustments.

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
